

Sunday Worship - The worship choir is committed to sing at all three services - twice a month. We will meet at 7:15am on these Sundays to warm-up, pray, and practice our songs once before the 8:00am service begins.

Rehearsals - Tuesday nights 6:00pm-8:00pm

- Every worship leader is expected to be at all rehearsals. As a leadership team, every member is an important asset to our ability to lead with diligence and mastery. (2 Corinthians 8:7)

At Home Practice

- It is vital that all worship leaders are actively becoming familiar with their own independent parts within each piece of music outside of the choir practice nights. With the limited time of each rehearsal, we simply cannot start each piece from “zero”. All members are expected to practice their own music at home. (Galatians 6:5)

Attire - Our objective is to be “unseen” when leading worship. We want to direct the focus unto the Lord, therefor, we want to dress uniform and clean. As a worship choir, we will all dress in:

- Bottoms: Black slacks/pants or a flat black skirt (below knee). Skirts, please wear flat black leggings so that no skin is showing below the waist.
- Tops: Solid (any color) top. No designs, patterns, sparkles, or two-toned designs. Shoulders must be covered.
- Feet: Black socks, black shoes. (Open toe is fine).
- Ladies, please keep make-up tasteful and to a minimum. Excess beauty can easily become a distraction for others.
- Perfume & cologne: Please abstain from any smells when attending practice and leading worship. All perfumes & colognes help to obstruct our breathing and voice.

Communication

- Worship choir team members are requested to notify the team leader if they know of any impending absences they will encounter.

Attitude

- Every member of the worship choir is a representative of our Lord, our Christian faith, Desert Springs Church, and our worship choir (2 Corinthians 5:20). The Bible is clear that leaders are held to a higher standard (James 3:1). As worship leaders, we need to actively prepare our hearts before stepping on stage to lead worship. This means we will all be there for each other to help encourage, motivate, and strengthen each other (Proverbs 27:17).
