

# MAJOR SCALE VIOLIN FINGERINGS

This chart displays the recommended fingering for the major scale in each of the twelve keys: G, Ab, A, Bb, B, C, Db, D, Eb, E, F, and Gb. Each scale is written on a single staff in its respective key signature. The notes are marked with finger numbers (1, 2, 3, 4) to indicate the optimal fingering for each note. The scales are arranged in ascending order of pitch, from G major at the top to Gb major at the bottom. The G major scale includes a natural 0 for the open string.
